

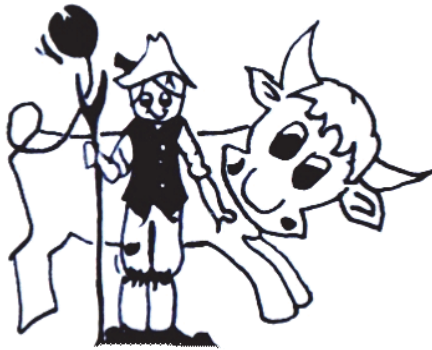

Junior Classes 2017

Class	Sort	Type	Description
1	NEP	Floral Art	Competitor to make and display an exhibit to depict a place visited by Phileas Fogg in the classic adventure novel 'Around the World in 80 days' written by Jules Verne. Exhibit Title: "Around the World in 80 Days". The maximum display area for each competitor MUST NOT exceed 60cm wide x 60cm deep x optional height (i.e. no limitations to height). Exhibits to be composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories. Exhibit is to be viewed from the front. Competitors own backboard and base boards are allowed, and must be provided by the competitor if required and must adhere to the size limitations. The Competitor will have 1 hour to create their piece.
2	E	Photography	Competitor to take and display three photographs entitled 'modes of transport from around the world'. Photographs must be mounted. Must be on photograph paper. No specific photo size but all 3 photos must fit on A3 paper.
3	E	Computer design	Competitor to design a 'new cover for the British Passport'. Max size A4. Printed design.
4	E	Creative Writing/Design	Competitor to design a two sided postcard to a pen pal in another Country. Telling them about 'a YFC event they have been to'. Must be hand written and addressed correctly. Max A5.
5	E	Craft	Competitor to make and display a jungle animal out of a wellie. Max size 60cm x 60cm x 60cm.
6	E	Needlework	Competitor to make and display a 3D Christmas decoration, using needlework skills. Any medium. Max size 30cm x 30cm x 30cm.
7	E	Cookery	Competitor to make and display 6 homemade sweets. Do not have to all be the same size. To be displayed on a side plate.
8	E	Art	Competitor to draw a famous landmark from around the World. Max size A4. No computer design.
9	E	Flower Arranging	Competitor to make and display a flower arrangement in a bucket you'd take on holiday, showing the colours of a Country's Flag. Name of the Country to be displayed with the arrangement. Max size 45cm x 45cm x unlimited.
10	E	Woodwork	Competitor to make and display a doorstep to the theme 'Round the World' Max size 60cm x 60cm x 60cm
11	E	Metalwork	Competitor to make and display three BBQ tools, which can be used on a BBQ. Max size 80cm x 80cm x 80cm.
12	PE	Cookery	A team of two to make and display 'a Mediterranean Salad & Dressing', to be presented in a salad bowl. Competitor to bring all ingredients and utensils. Time allowed 15 minutes. To be displayed in the Exhibition tent if the Competitor wishes once completed.
13	P	Craft	Competitor to make and display a 'Cup and Saucer' out of a material to be provided on the day. Time allowed 10 minutes.
14	P	Identification	Team of two to identify 10 Countries from Anagrams. Time allowed 10 minutes.
15	P	Novelty	Team of three to do a Penalty Shootout – 6 balls allowed. Goalkeeper & balls will be supplied.
16	P	Novelty	Team of two, one competitor to draw the Flag of a Country onto the other competitors face. Competitors to bring own make up. Time allowed 10 minutes.
17	P	Novelty	Team of four, all to remove apples out of a bucket of water and run over an assault course. The apple must stay in Competitors mouth.
18	P	Novelty	Team of two, to run a three legged egg and spoon race.
19	P	Machinery	Competitor to drive a compact tractor & a mounted implement over a prescribed course. Competitor to be 13 years or over on the day of the competition. Appropriate PPE as per the rules. Parental consent is required. Appropriate clothing and footwear to be worn.

Intermediate Classes 2017

20	NEP	Floral Art	Competitor to make and display an Exhibit Titled – “Your Passport to Adventure, What will your Discovery Be?” An Exhibit to depict your dream YFC Travel Trip from the 2017 Travel Programme (available on National YFC Website). Country must be stated. The maximum display area for each competitor MUST NOT exceed 60cm wide x 60cm deep x optional height (i.e. no limitations to height). Exhibits to be composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories. Exhibit is to be viewed from the front. Competitors own backboard and base boards are allowed, and must be provided by the competitor. Competitor to have 1 hour to create their piece.
21	E	Photography	Competitor to take and display three photographs of a ‘Non domestic animal/wildlife from around the World’. Must be mounted. No specific size for the photographs but all 3 photos must fit on A3 paper.
22	E	Art	Competitor to make, display and decorate a hot air balloon out of papier mache with a basket. The basket can be made from any medium. To be hung on the day. Max size 50cm x 50cm x 50cm.
23	E	Computer design	Competitor to make a holiday leaflet for ‘a destination of your choice’. Max size A4.
24	E	Creative Writing	Competitor to write the Minutes of a YFC Meeting which ‘consisted of a talk from a Travel Rep’. Must be displayed in correct order from start to finish and be hand written. Max size A4.
25	E	Craft	Competitor to make and display ‘anything you would like’ out of Origami. Max size 45cm x 45cm
26	E	Craft	Competitor to decorate a Dinner plate to the theme ‘Round the World’. Max size 50cm x 50cm
27	E	Flower arranging	Competitor to make and display a flower arrangement to the theme ‘The Globe’. Must fit in display area of 45cm x 45cm
28	E	Needlework	Competitor to make and display an Applique Cushion. Max size 45cm x 45cm
29	E	Cookery	Competitor to make and display a traybake decorated with a Flag from a Country around the World. Must be accompanied with a picture of the Country the Flag is from. Max size 50cm x 50cm.
30	E	Woodwork	Competitor to make and display three Mushrooms/Toadstool’s. All three must be different sizes. Max display area 30cm x 30cm.
31	E	Metalwork	Competitor to make and display a portable BBQ suitable for use on the beach. To be displayed outside.
32	PE	Cookery	Competitor to make an edible present. Competitor to provide all materials. No cooking allowed. Time allowed 15 minutes. To be displayed in the Exhibition tent if the Competitor wishes, once completed.
33	P	Identification	Team of two to identify Fifteen Flags from around the World. Time allowed 15 minutes.
34	P	Novelty	Team of two, Egyptian Mummy Race - each competitor to dress each other in loo roll and to both run over an obstacle course. Competitors to supply loo rolls. Timed.
35	P	Novelty	Team of four, to sing/perform a song from ‘Eurovision’. Competitors to provide music on Ipod and to dress in appropriate clothing for the song. Time allowed 5 minutes.
36	P	Novelty	Competitor to carry two buckets of water secured on a wooden bar, to be carried over competitor’s shoulders, over an obstacle course.
37	P	Novelty	Team of two, one competitor to do the other competitors make up to the theme ‘Gacia Girl’. Competitor to supply all makeup.
38	P	Machinery	Competitor to prepare the Tractor & attach too an Ifor Williams trailer and drive around a prescribed course. The Class is not open to Junior Members. Appropriate clothing & footwear to be worn.

Senior Classes 2017

39	NEP	Floral	Competitor to make and display an Exhibit Titled: "A World Famous Celebration" An Exhibit to depict a national celebration/festival from your chosen country anywhere in the world. Country Celebration/Festival must be stated. The maximum display area for each competitor MUST NOT exceed 60cm wide x 60cm deep x optional height (i.e. no limitations to height). Exhibits to be composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories. Exhibit is to be viewed from the front. Competitors own backboard and base boards are allowed, and must be provided by the competitor if required. Competitor to have 1 hour to create their piece.
40	E	Photography	Competitor to take and display three photographs titled 'What your mother wouldn't like to see'. Photographs must be mounted. No specific size for the photographs but they must fit on A3 paper.
41	E	Art	Competitor to draw and display a sketch of the Berkshire YFC County Field Officer. Max size A4.
42	E	Creative Writing	Competitor to write a job application letter for a job 'to become a tour operator organising safari holidays'. Max A4 size. Must be handwritten.
43	E	Computer design	Competitor to design a leaflet to promote an International YFC Camp. Max size A4.
44	E	Craft	Competitor to make and display a fascinator suitable to be worn at a wedding. Max size 60cm x 60cm x 60cm.
45	E	Flower arranging	Competitor to make and display a flower arrangement in a trough for a National Event from around the World. Must be displayed with what & where the event is. Max size 45cm x 45cm x 45cm.
46	E	Needlework	Competitor to make and display a beach bag. No maximum size.
47	E	Cookery	Competitor to make and display a celebration cake for a Country's National Day. Must display what National Day it is and why you have chosen the cake. Max size 60cm x 60cm x 60cm.
48	PE	Cookery	Competitor to make and display a picnic for 2 people to take to the beach. To be made on the day and displayed in exhibition tent when finished. Max size 80cm x 80cm.
49	E	Woodwork	Competitor to make and display a two handled tray. No maximum size but must be displayed upright.
50	E	Metalwork	Competitor to make and display a model of the Eiffel Tower. Max size 60cm x 60cm x 1m. To be displayed outside.
51	E	Craft	Competitor to make and display an item out of baler twine. Max size 80cm x 80cm x 80cm.
52	P	Identification	Team of two to identify 15 Countries from the shape of the Country. Time allowed 15 mins.
53	P	Novelty	Team of two, one to dress the other competitor in National Dress. Competitors to provide costumes and props.
54	P	Novelty	Team of four, to have all left wellies tied together and all right wellies tied together and then walk/run over an obstacle course. The leader of the team will be blindfolded. Wellies to be provided by competitor.
55	P	Novelty	Fairy liquid challenge – Competitor to slide along a plastic sheet covered in water & fairy liquid. Furthest competitor wins. Competitor must wear old clothes!.
56	P	Novelty	Competitor to take part in a jousting competition using water balloons!. Weapons will be provided.
57	P	Machinery	Competitor to re-thread both top and bottom strings in one knotter on a large square baler & to replace one ball of twine. Competitor must also talk through the daily servicing on a baler to the Judge. No driving required. Appropriate clothing and footwear to be worn.

58	NE	Cube Exhibit	<p>Competitors (the Club Team) to be 26 years of age or under on 1 September 2016. An Exhibit to depict the theme of "Around the World". This theme can be interpreted in any way that the club sees fit. The Club Team is required to exhibit 5 crafts. 1 craft from each of the headings below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Craft 1 - Floral Art (Any item using cut flowers and accessories in a suitable container) • Craft 2 – Cookery/Baking (This craft will be tasted so must be covered with cling film). • Craft 3 – Textile Handicraft (Any sewn item, may include wool, embroidery or tapestry for example) • Craft 4 – Natural Handicraft (Any item using wood, metal, clay, glass, stone or shell for example) • Craft 5 – Art Handicraft (Any art based item using any medium, may include decoupage, calligraphy or photography for example). <p>The five (5) crafts need to be clearly marked 1-5 together with the heading the craft comes under. For example 1- Floral Art, 2 – Cookery, 3- Sewn Handicraft, 4- Natural Handicraft, 5- Art Handicraft. Each Exhibit to be 1m x 1m x 1m. Any accessories or drapes used on the outside of the external walls of the cube will be included in the overall measurement of the exhibit. The exhibit must have 3 walls.</p>
59	E	Cookery	Competitor to make and display a meal suitable for lunch on a long haul flight. List of ingredients and method to be displayed. Max display area 50cm x 50cm
60	E	Horticulture	Competitor to depict another Country other than the UK in a seed tray, using plants and accessories. Max size 45cm x 45cm
61	E	Art	Competitor to design the front cover for the 2017-2018 Berkshire Federation of Young Farmers' Clubs Yearbook. Competitor to be mindful of printing costs. Winning cover to be used for next yearbook. Computer aided work is acceptable. Size A5.
62	E	Craft	Team of 4 to decorate a dump bag which will be used on the day in the dump bag race.
63	P	Novelty	Team of 4 to take part in the dump bag race using their dump bag which they entered into the exhibit tent. (above class). No dump bags will be provided on the day.
64	E	Art/Craft	Competitors (can be a Club Team) to design and display the front page of a Holiday Companies Website showing a number of holidays chosen by the team, using cutouts from magazines or holiday brochures. Max size A3. No computer design.
65	E	Publicity	Club to display their promotion boards. Must include up to date programme of events/meetings and current contact details. Boards suitable to attract new members.
66	P	Craft/Skill	Upcycle. Team of 4 to upcycle a pallet into anything that represents the theme 'Round the World'. Competitors must bring their own tools.
67	E	Cookery	Competitor to make and display a meal which is suitable for an Evening Dinner on a Cruise Liner. List of ingredients and method to be displayed. Max display are 80cm x 80cm
68	E	Computer Design	Competitor to make and display a collage showcasing YFC to another Country. Max size A3.
69	P	Novelty	Team of two, to perform 2 first aid tasks given on the day by the judge. All equipment will be provided. Timed.
70	P	Novelty	Team of 4 to take part in an Ancient Greek Chariot race. Teams to provide their own Chariots.
71	P	Entertainment	Britain's got YFC Talent. Sing, dance, play, mime or entertain Unlimited team number. Any background music to be supplied by the team on an Ipod. Team can be members & associate members. Max time allowed 5 minutes.
72	P	Dance	Team of any size (can include members & associate members) to perform a Traditional dance from around the World. Music & costume to be supplied by the team. Music must be on an ipod. Max time allowed 5 minutes.
73	P	Novelty	Vehicle Challenge – Clubs to fit as many members and associate members in a Vehicle!. Time 15 mins.
74	P	Ladies Tug of War	Team of eight pulling members. No more than two (2) members of the team shall be between the ages of 15 and under 17 on 1/9/16 and a minimum of four must be between 17 & 26 years of age on 1/9/16. No more than two

			associate members.
75	P	Men's Tug of War	Team of eight pulling members. No more than two (2) members of the team shall be between the ages of 15 and under 17 on 1/9/16 and a minimum of four must be between 17 & 26 years of age on 1/9/16. No more than two associate members.
76	P	Tug of War Mixed (12-18yrs)	Team of between 7 and 10 pulling members male and/or female who must be 12 years of age and over and under 17 years on 1/9/16. NATIONAL RULES APPLY
77	P	Co-operative	Clubs to produce a carnival style float (walking or mechanised) to the theme 'Round the World'. All persons taking part in the co-operative must hold a valid membership card. Where trailers are used a suitable and sturdy barrier or handrail must be in place.
78	P	Ticket sales	Clubs and their members to sell as many Grand draw tickets as possible. Clubs with the highest sales per head of membership will win.
